

## **Public comments on Energy Efficiency Building Code of Sri Lanka -2020**

The clause 36 (g) of the Sri Lanka Sustainable Energy Authority Act, No.35 of 2007 empowers the SEA to specify and enforce a Code of practice on efficient energy utilisation in buildings. Giving due regard to this, SEA published the Code of Practice for Energy Efficient Buildings in Sri Lanka in year 2008 which was expected to be complied with on voluntary basis.

With the passage of time, modern and efficient technologies have entered the market, necessitating a fresh approach. SEA has initiated the revision of this Code with the assistance of a consulting firm and a draft document was prepared. Thus, SEA wishes to obtain the views and comments of experts in the building sector representing academics, professionals, enforcement authorities, energy utilities, engineers, architects and users of the Code, prior to its publication.

Therefore, you are kindly requested to provide your views and comments on this Code. Your submission is expected to reach us by Email or by hand on or before 12<sup>th</sup> October 2020.
