This refers to your application dated \_\_\_\_\_ for a Permit for the On-grid Renewable Energy Project described above.

\_\_\_\_\_ (name of applicant) (hereinafter referred to as the "Developer"), has been granted a Renewable Energy Permit (hereinafter referred to as the "Permit") under Section 18 of the Sri Lanka Sustainable Energy Authority Act 35 of 2007, (herein after referred to as the "Act"). The permit number as indicated above should be used in all future correspondence with the Sri Lanka Sustainable Energy Authority (herein after referred to as the "Authority") and documentation relating to the Project.

This Permit is issued subject to the following Terms and Conditions:-

1. This Permit shall be valid for a period of twenty years (20) from the date of commencement of commercial operations. Accordingly, this permit shall expire on DD/MM/YYYY.
2. The Plant should deliver not less than fifty percent (50%) of the nominal annual energy delivery or minimum guaranteed energy as defined in the respective Small Power Purchase Agreement or other similar Agreement, for a continuous period of five (5) years from the date of commencement of commercial operations.
3. The Plant shall be operated in accordance with the relevant standards of the Ceylon Electricity Board.
4. Utilisation of the renewable energy resource and structures required to harness the same shall conform to the relevant standards, regulations and codes as stipulated by the relevant approving authorities.
5. Any costs incurred by the Developer in the fulfilment of requirements, terms and conditions specified in this Permit shall not be the responsibility of the Authority and shall be borne entirely by the Developer.
6. The Developer shall take all necessary measures to use the renewable energy resource allocated for the Project with due diligence, during the operational life of the Project.
7. The Developer shall not undertake any capacity additions during the operational life of the project, above the permitted installed capacity stipulated in the Permit.
8. Where any damage is caused to the energy resource being utilised for the Project due to the negligence or lack of due diligence of the Developer, the Developer shall be liable to pay the Authority such amount as compensation, as the Minister may determine in consultation with the Minister of Finance.
9. Any extensions to existing Small Power Purchase Agreement or other similar Agreement that may be required during the validity of this Permit shall be based on rules, terms and conditions applicable to such extensions. [special clause needed because EP validity exceeds SPPA validity]
10. If at any time during the validity of this Permit, the terms and conditions stipulated herein are violated by the Developer, the Director General of the Authority, with the Approval of the Authority, shall have the power to cancel this Permit, under paragraph (b) subsection (1) of section 21 of the Act.
